

Galter LifeCenter Winter Weather Advisory FAQ

How safe is it for me to travel to Galter LifeCenter during bad weather?

Though we will try our best to keep the sidewalks and parking lots salted during bad weather, we cannot guarantee that there won't be patches of snowy or icy pavement throughout the day. Please keep that in mind before you travel to Galter LifeCenter.

Where should I park during a storm?

During inclement weather, we recommend parking in the member parking lot or the Swedish Hospital garage. The Courtesy Desk provides free validation tickets to members who park in the garage.

All street parking, including the diagonal parking slots on Francisco Ave., are owned by the city of Chicago and are not managed by Galter LifeCenter. When snow is over two inches deep, there is no parking available from 3 a.m. to 7 a.m. on Foster Ave. December 1 through April 1 due to city snow route restrictions.
